(inclusion of Scope 1 and 2 emissions (Scope 3 to be phased in over a four-year timeframe) in measuring carbon intensity)</li><li>&gt; At least 7% reduction per year in carbon intensity (inclusion of Scope 1 and 2 emissions (Scope 3 to be phased in over a four-year timeframe) in measuring carbon intensity)</li><li>&gt; Sufficient exposure to high climate impact sectors (NACE Industry Codes A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, L): at least equal to that of the investable universe</li></ul>
