List of environmental factors considered	> Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >1% from mining and liquefaction of coal. Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >5% from power generation from coal. > Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >50% from production and processing of natural gas conventional methods. > Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >10% from production and processing of crude oil conventional methods. > Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >50% from power generation from fossil fuels. > Exclusion of any companies that fail to comply with the environment-related principles of the United Nations Global Compact.
List of social factors considered	> Exclusion of companies showing any involvement in production and trading of weapons, weapon systems, controversial weapons, i.e., nuclear, biological, and chemical weapons, cluster munitions, anti-personnel mines, and uranium ammunition. > Exclusion of any companies that fail to comply with the social-related principles of the United Nations Global Compact
List of governance factors considered	> Exclusion of any companies that fail to comply with the governance-related principles of the United Nations Global Compact.

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Verification and quality of data	The provider of ESG-related data input is selected by the Administrator based on an assessment of its existing processes in order to ensure the reliability and representativeness of the ESG-related data. The data provider has established processes in accordance with accepted and established market standards that ensure the permanent quality and reliability of the ESG-data provided.
